**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject:- Lok Sabha unstarred question no. 4239 regarding financial assistance to Lakshadweep, to be answered on 20/02/2014.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to P&P section's O.M. No. H-11011/01/2014-P&P dated 14/02/2014 on the above mentioned subject and to furnish the following information relating to Lok Sabha unstarred question no. 4239 for answer on 20/02/14:

(a) to (c) The Ministry of Rural Development was earlier implementing Swarnajayanti Gram Swarajgar Yojna (SGSY). SGSY has been restructured as National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM), subsequently renamed as 'Aajeevika' and it was launched on 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2011. After a transition period of two years, SGSY has ceased to exist with effect from 1.4.2013. It may be added that financial assistance under NRLM is not given to the Panchayats. Funds under NRLM are directly given to State Rural Livelihoods Missions (SRLM).

Lakshadweep has not transitioned to National Rural Livelihoods Mission as yet. The details regarding the allocation and release to the Union Territory of Lakshadweep under SGSY is given at annexure I.
